

Breathing Apparatus Instructor Revalidation (BAIR) Course



Safe, effective BA training is essential to any fire service and your BAIs are a critical resource in ensuring the crews at your station can use BA competently and confidently. How do you currently revalidate the competence of your BAIs and how do you demonstrate that this is done objectively?

Course Overview

The BAIR programme has been developed by IFTC in line with *Department for Communities and Local Government, National Operation Guidance 2014 (NOG14)*.

The course will comprise:

- A refresh of legislation to keep the knowledge current.
- A review of delivery methods so the training is engaging and effective.
- Being tasked with the development of a training plan to meet the required assessment of the BA wearer.
- One day of CFBT for high impact learning on fire growth and response tactics.
- Two days of exercises in the multi-compartment rig and hot box.

On successful completion of all assessments a certificate of achievement will be issued to each individual following a demonstration of competence.

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Pre-Course Requirements

All attendees need to have attended a BAI course previously and demonstrate a maintenance of competence in this field. Courses will be limited to eight delegates.
